4. CAR status	<p>Does the CAR develop according to the plans? Please describe: NOFOBE had its startup in 2016. The project administration group had three meetings in 2016; startup meeting 2016.05.04 (Skype-meeting), 2016.05.25 and 2016.11.15. November 15th-16th NOFOBE had a workshop at Arlanda, Sweden with 7 participants from the NOFOBE project administration group. Plans for the remaining NOFOBE-period was developed. The participants also gave presentations from ongoing research activity.</p> <p>The NOFOBE webpage have been updated with information about the project and relevant activity among the project partners.</p> <p>Does the CAR deviate from the plans? Please explain: The activity in the startup-year of NOFOBE has been in line with the project application. The incurred costs has been lower, mainly because of synergies in coordinating the NOFOBE-activities with the SSFE Biennial meeting.</p>

<p>5. Activities during the reporting year</p>	<p>The main activity of NOFOBE in 2016 was the Forest-Based Bioeconomy Week (FBBW) which took place during the week 24th – 27th of May, 2016. The FBBW took place in Norway, at Gardermoen (24th of May) and continued at Oscarsborg 25th-27th of May.</p> <p>NOFOBE has set up an activity called Short Term Scientific Missions (STSM) to promote exchange of researchers, Ph.D.-students and Post.Doc.s among institutions in the Nordic/Baltic countries. 2 such stipends were awarded in 2016, Elias Hurmekoski and Alex Moiseev from EFI-HQ, Finland visited NMBU, Department of Ecology and Natural Resource Management, Norway during the second half of May 2016. One research article is currently in review for publication based on this STSM.</p>
<p>6. Results achieved during the reporting year</p>	<p>The FBBW 2016 was arranged 24th – 27th of May with around 70 participants in total.</p> <p>In total, around 80 scientific presentations were given the FBBW 2016.</p> <p>A field trip/excursion was arranged on 25th of May oriented towards modern ways of using forest biomass, see program attached.</p>

Publishing and communication during the reporting year International scientific peer reviewed journals, other scientific publications, short communications, web etc.)</p>	<p><u>Scandinavian Forest Economics Vol. 46</u>, 234 pp Proceedings of the Biennial meeting of the Scandinavian Society of Forest Economics.</p> <p>A special issue (SI) of Journal of Forest Economics (JFE) is under editing and revision. 5-6 articles based on presentations given during the FBBW 2016 are currently in the review process. The SI is planned to be published in the fall of 2017. Hans Fredrik Hoen is Guest editor for the special issue.</p>
