- a) Yes, the project develops according to plans.
- b) Activities:
 - A workshop with 35 participants was organized by the Danish partner, back to back with the Nordic Cooperation for Forest Inventory. The workshop included 25 presentations and an excursion. The overreaching aim of the meeting was to enhance knowledge and synergies among the Nordic NFI's within resource projections and biodiversity monitoring based on forest inventory data. Subsequently, the aim of the meeting hence was to 1) discuss different approaches to forest resource prediction, 2) disseminate knowledge on the precision and problems associated with various approaches, 3) synthesize state-of-the art in forest resource projections, and 4) assess and discusses the consequences for the determination of reference levels in relation to climate gas reporting.  - Part of the CARISMA activities are now also ongoing in the ERA-GAS funded project INVENT, which is one outcome of CARISMA.
 - The core group had five Skype meetings for the discussion of research issues and project management related to the forthcoming workshops.
 - A logo for the 2019 CARISMA conference "A century of national forest inventories informing past, present and future decisions" was developed. SNS helped spreading the news about the conference via Twitter.
 - The Twitter account @NFI100 was created for covering the CARISMA and SNS funded conference "A century of national forest inventories informing past, present and future decisions" in Norway from 19 to 23 May 2019. It is planned to hand over the account to the next NFIs celebrating their 100 years anniversary (Finland in 2021).
