Nordic Forest Research (SNS)

BACKGROUND

The summer of 2018 was extraordinary in the Nordic countries. Hot and dry weather caused more and bigger fires than normal. These fires called for urgent measures and put both the national preparatory work and international cooperation to the test. The Nordic Council of Ministers decided in September 2018 to establish a working group to systematize the Nordic countries' experiences from forest fires in 2018, and to propose areas of cooperation that can contribute to a more resilient Nordic forestry. Nordic Forest Research (SNS) will now establish a permanent network based on the recommendations in the report written by the working group.
