SNS wishes to support research projects for three years addressing topics related to sustainable management of forest resources, as well as projects exploring ways to balance different/conflicting goals related to forests. The aim of the call is to interlink projects initiated in the Nordic region, increase synergies in forest research, promote cross sectoral collaboration and bridge gaps between research and forestry in practice.
