FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES:

Funding intruments are at the core of SNS's work. We provide the following opportunities:

Annual Networks: One year networks that establish closer collaboration and enhance Nordic synergies in forest research. Networks can for example organize workshops, write policy recommendations, research applications, and create databases.

Research Projects: Three-year funded research projects addressing specific research questions from a Nordic perspective.

NordForNet: Five-year funded networks supporting long-term networking with an interdisciplinary approach and a strong policy connection.

PhD Courses: Funding for organisation of PhD courses in forests and forestry with a Nordic component to facilitate cross border exchange contributing to synergies and collaboration.

NordGen Forest/SNS Scholarship:

Funding for education, training, and knowledge exchange in the fields of forest seed and plant production, regeneration methods, and tree breeding. Administered by NordGen Forest.
